GENERAL SERVICES COMMISSIONER— SALE OF LANDS
CHAPTER 836

Approved and effective Aug. 2, 1986

AN ACT authorizing the commissioner of the office of general services to accept title to the Saugerties lighthouse and thereafter to sell such lighthouse to the Saugerties lighthouse conservancy

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The commissioner of the office of general services is authorized to accept title to the Saugerties lighthouse from the United States Coast Guard and to permit the Saugerties lighthouse conservancy to perform stabilization work on the lighthouse. Thereafter, such commissioner is authorized to sell and convey the Saugerties lighthouse and adjoining wetland area to the Saugerties lighthouse conservancy at such time and upon such terms and conditions as such commissioner may fix and determine, including payment of the consideration of one dollar.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
